Project Scope

WHAT IS INCLUDED:

1. **2.1 Overview**

2. SecurePay Hub and ACH require several shopping cart modules plug ins as per the scope outlined above to be available to download to support its merchants. These modules are to be available both via the market place and to be sent direct to the merchants.

3. 2.2 How it Works

- 4. Merchants wishing to access shopping carts that 'plug into' the Secure Pay Hub or AlphaHub can do so by selecting the required icon from the market place and by following the instructions on how to download and install.
- 5. Alternatively, the merchant can be sent the plug in on request and be sent the module via email along with installation instructions.

7. 2.3.1 Module Configuration

The following fields have been identified as being In-Scope for Shopping Cart Plug in Module configuration:

- > Payment Method Title > Payment Method Name
- > User ID
- > Merchant ID
- ➤ Merchant TX ID ➤ Currency
- > Test Mode Flag

2.3.2 Core Module Features

Transaction types:

> Authorise

- > Authorise and capture (requires follow up API call)
- > Allowed card types (Visa, M/C, Amex)
- ➤ Display receipt page (display result on hosted payment page once the payment is hosted) ➤ Store transaction response data against each other

Alternative Payments

o POLi and PayPal. These are to be selectable on the hosted payment page and the different responses back to merchant need to be accounted so that settlement occurs correctly.

Card Capture (Transaction)

- o Card capture is to be via Hosted Payment Page
- o Capture transaction via API called by a capture button against an authorised order in ADMIN. Allows
- a merchant to flag that a transaction should be captured (settled) if the auth is successful

Additional Requirements (Phase 2 Additions)

Card Capture

- Token Storage Flag
- Pay with stored card: use stored card via API call for returning customers

Visa Checkout, UPOP, ApplePay (including changes required to interpret payment response and perform follow up settlement functions)

Refunds

Refund order via API called by a refund button on admin order screen

Cancel

Cancel an authorisation via API called by a cancel button against an authorised order in admin
